














STRATEGIES FOR MANAGING THE RISK

Call To Action

- Develop an approach that balances diner safety and economic concerns
- Utilize a permit process including indemnification language and insurance requirements to transfer the risk
- Close streets or limit outdoor dining to roadways with speed limits 30 mph and below
- Utilize crash-tested barriers to separate diners from moving vehicles
- Conduct regular inspections of outdoor dining installations
