Start Early



Start Planning Early

Allows for forecasting procurement usage for local programs and DSP agreements

Coordinate across departments and with local entities for procurement needs at the beginning of the year for use within jurisdiction limits:

Note: for delivery areas where a semi-truck cannot fit, smaller trucks with less capacity would need to be utilized, increasing delivery coordination
